- 1. Reduction of inappropriate drug use in dementia (RID) study
- 2. Living home with dementia: a comprehensive educational program for people with dementia and their spouses, living in the community
- 3. Online Life story book: design and measuring efficacy for a online tool to increase reminiscence in dementia
- 4. Paratonia and dementia: incidence, development and assessment of paratonia in residents with dementia

1. Development of an assessment instrument to measure inappropriate psychotropic drug use

- 3. Adapting the physical environment in nursing homes
- 4. Shared decision making in psychotropic drug prescription in dementia
